ROMAN HOLIDAY MYSTERY QUILT - AUGUST CLUES

August Piecing: (no more cutting - aren't you glad?!)

Retrieve the units you made last month, and the **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles you cut in May. Sew one **Fabric C** rectangle to each long side of the unit.

Trim to 8-1/2" square.

This completes **Block C**, and you should have 17-31-49 blocks.

Making Rows:

You're ready to put the blocks together into rows! Refer to the illustrations below for the size of your quilt. (Note that the Full Size illustration is shown with fussy-cut centers for Block B.)

Odd-numbered rows are created by alternating **Block A** and **Block C - rotated vertically**. Press seams toward **Block A**.

Even-numbered rows are created by alternating Block~C - rotated~horizontally and Block~B.

Press seams toward Block B.

Join rows, matching seams.
