August Piecing: (no more cutting - aren't you glad?!)
Retrieve the units you made last month, and the Fabric C 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles you cut in May. Sew one Fabric $\mathbf{C}$ rectangle to each long side of the unit.

Trim to 8-1/2" square.
This completes Block C, and you should have 17-31-49 blocks.

## Making Rows:

You're ready to put the blocks together into rows! Refer to the illustrations below for the size of your quilt. (Note that the Full Size illustration is shown with fussy-cut centers for Block B.)

Odd-numbered rows are created by alternating Block A and Block C - rotated vertically. Press seams toward Block A.

Even-numbered rows are created by alternating Block C - rotated horizontally and Block B. Press seams toward Block B.

Join rows, matching seams.
